

DIRECTIONS TO MOUNTAIN LAKES DISTRICT AND COMMUNITY

CENTER, WOODSVILLE, NEW HAMPSHIRE

From Hartford, CT, go north on I-91 to Wells River, Vermont Exit #17. Turn right off the ramp onto Route 302, continue to the town of Wells River, go right on Route 5 briefly, past the Happy Hour Restaurant on your left and turn left across the bridge, this is Route 302 again. Continue on across bridge to the town of Woodsville. Go all the way to the intersection where Foggs' Hardware is on the right and the Woodsville Elementary School is on the left and turn left.

This is still Route 302 going towards Littleton, NH, continue until you see a sign on the right for Route 112 and there is a campground on the right. Turn right and follow Route 112 into the town of Swiftwater, past the covered bridge on the left, sharp corner there and past the Swiftwater Store on the right. A short way further is a sign for Mountain Lakes and French Pond Road on the right. Turn onto French Pond Road until you see the green and white Mountain Lakes sign on the right. Turn right and go past the mailboxes on the left and the pool on the right and the Mountain Lakes Community Center and Office Building is across the causeway between the two lakes.

DIRECTIONS TO MOUNTAIN LAKES – THE LODGE

Go past the Mountain Lakes sign on French Pond Road until you reach Valley Road on your left. Continue on Valley Road to the third right and follow the little drive to the Lodge.

FROM BOSTON, MA go north on I-93 to Lincoln and North Woodstock, NH exit #32. Take the turn for Route 112 West and it is about 13 miles to Mountain Lakes. Just before the Mountain Lakes sign, there is the Swiftwater Stage Stop store (log building) on your right, take a left turn onto French Pond Road and the sign for Mountain Lakes will be on your right.

Continue on French Pond Road until you see the green and white Mountain Lakes sign on the right. Turn there, go past the mailboxes on the left and the pool on the right and the Mountain Lakes Community Center and Office Building is across the causeway between the two lakes.

Directions to the Lodge are the same as above.
