

**MOUNTAIN LAKES DISTRICT  
EMERGENCY COMMISSIONERS MEETING  
April 1, 2013**

**Call to Order:** Chris Demers called the meeting to order at 6:05 pm.

**Highlights of discussion re: annual meeting voter issue**

Chris Demers stated the purpose of the meeting was to review information provided by the district's attorneys to consider a proposal to resolve the annual meeting voting issue. Chris Demers then excused himself from any decision making and sat in the audience to avoid the appearance of a conflict of interest.

Bob Long stated he had just finished a conversation with the attorney's office and they were recommending the two candidates, Ken King and Chris Demers, each sign an affidavit saying they agree with the petition for a special district meeting. At Ken King's request, item 2 was removed from the affidavit and the revised copies were sent to the attorneys for approval before being signed on April 2 in front of a notary public.

Mike Bonanno asked if photo IDs were required for voting. Bob Long stated by law in the state of New Hampshire IDs are required to vote, but we were told they were not required for our vote. Mike Bonanno asked what would happen if a third candidate decided they wanted to run for commissioner. Bob Long stated he would check with the attorney for an answer to that question. Mike Bonanno asked about use of official ballots so that the district could use absentee ballots. Bob Long stated changing from unofficial ballots to official ballots can only be voted on at an annual meeting, and the district has looked into the issue several times in the past and has decided not to do it.

Laraine King requested the later date of May 11th be chosen for the special district meeting so people have time to make arrangements to attend. Polly Bonanno asked to listen the recording of the annual meeting and said she would make an appointment with Kristi Garofalo to do so. Ken King asked that page 3, article 12 of the petition to the court be changed to "at least three others, that claimed they were registered to vote in the Town of Haverhill..." and Bob Long said he would make that change and give it to the attorneys.

Bob Long made a motion that the district hold a special district meeting on Saturday, May 11, 2013. Beverly Jacobs seconded. Both Bob Long and Beverly Jacobs voted in favor and the motion passed.

Bob Long made a motion that the district petition the superior court for permission to hold an election for commissioner at the special district meeting on Saturday, May 11, 2013. Beverly Jacobs seconded. Both Bob Long and Beverly Jacobs voted in favor and the motion passed.

Bob Long made a motion to adjourn and Beverly Jacobs seconded. Meeting was adjourned at 6:35 pm.
