Follow-up on Action Items:

1. Investigation of possible use of flat-screen TV for used at the Community Center and Lodge. No action at this time.
2. MLD Signage.
  - a. Follow-up needed with Francine Bowman regarding the cost of new sign for Community Center building. Laraine is to make notes of current signs and give correct/updated information to Francine for new signs for the beach and pool areas.
    - i. Discussion was held regarding the age of unsupervised children at the beach and pool areas. It was agreed upon that children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult.
    - ii. A separate "No Smoking" sign will be hung at the pool and also added to the sign of Rules and Regulations posted there.
3. Survey – Heather will send out another email to Committee members asking for their input on the Recreation survey. She has also offered to design a FaceBook page for the Committee.
4. Tennis Courts – no update as this time. Current keys are to be checked and additional keys made for the upcoming season.
5. Ice Cream Socials – a correction was made to the Minutes that the socials scheduled in July and August are at no cost to the District. The ice cream and all materials are donated by Jim Fallon.
6. Lodge Rules and Hours of Operation – tabled until next meeting.
