

## **Mountain Lakes District Water Committee Report for August 2014**

This report covers the monthly meeting of 8/7/14.

### **Mountain Lakes District Water Committee Meeting of 8/7/14**

This was the July Water Committee Meeting. It was held from 7:30 AM to 8:30 AM on 8/7/14. Attendees: Don Drew – Water Department, Bob Long – Commissioner, Robert Roudebush, Peter Olander, Tony Salvucci, Dan Brady - Guest, and Ken King - Chair.

We approved the Water Committee Report for July, 2014.

### **Dan Brady**

Dan wanted us to consider some way of providing a mooring on the upper lake for homeowners who have boats on the lower lake during the lowering of the lake in next year's construction project. He said we could do this in a simple fashion with just a long rope between two posts and suggested it be placed on the upper lake where the mail boxes are.

We agreed that this was a good idea but not a good location for it because of the problems in getting to the shore line in that area. Don suggested that we build two new boat racks (which are needed anyway) and make them available to homeowners on the lower lake.

### **Water System Status**

The system is running well. We are using 27 to 33 thousand gallons per day, which is normal for this time of the year.

We are still collecting information on issues with the pump on Bedrock Well #4. Bob wanted to understand the cost of the electricity to run the pump.

There was a water service leak on Hanover Drive that was repaired by the homeowner's contractor, a chamber alarm caused by a power failure, and a report of low pressure on White Mountain Road that was internal to the home.

We had to install a new riser top for the air release valve on Hill Top Drive.

The Water Department truck will need tires and new ball joints before the Fall inspection.

### **Jim Vernon – Nobis Engineering**

Jim Vernon was here to start work on our new water source development project. He reviewed all of the information that we have and the work done by Don on possible sites. He does need a digital copy of the Mountain Lakes lots in order to align that with the information he has on possible source sites. We can get this from the town at a cost of \$250.00.

### **Lower Dam Outflow Project**

We know that at some time we will also have to do an upper dam outflow reconstruction. Bob wanted to take another look at this to see if it might be able to couple it with the lower dam work.
