Mountain Lakes District Water Committee Meeting of 8/3/17

Meeting was held from 8:10 AM to 8:45 AM. Attendees: Don Drew, Ken King, Mark Johanson, and Mike Roberts

Water System Update:

The water system is operating normally and production is about 40 thousand gallons per day which is normal for the summer time.

Incident Reports:

A home owner needed help in dealing with an outdoor faucet that would not shut off.

A Lakeside home needed to get a Backflow and pressure reducer installed.

There was a water break on Lakeside drive the morning of the meeting. It was fixed that same day.

Water Meters:

We have determined the supplier for the meters. The first meter in the distribution network will be part of the Bear Road project.

Bear Road Project:

All of the material needed for the project has been delivered to Horne Excavating. The project will probably not start until the Fall in order to minimize the impact on the homes, most of which are not active at that time.

Master Plan:

A Public Hearing of the latest version of the updated Master Plan will be held on Saturday August 12th following the 9:00 AM Commissioners Meeting at the Lodge. An online copy is available or you can pick up a printed copy at the office.

Lower Dam Project:

We are still waiting for the state to do an inspection of the dam and the spillway.

Nobis Engineering – Water Sourcing:

Nobis and Geophysics did use the ground penetrating radar in the vicinity of the MtBE location. They did find two objects buried in that area. A separate group will now come and excavate the two items.
