

Mountain Lakes District Water Committee Report for November 2017

Mountain Lakes District Water Committee Meeting of 12/7/17.

Meeting was held from 8:05 AM to 8:45 AM. Attendees: Bob Long, Don Drew, Ken King, Ed Rajsteter, Mark Johanson and Tony Salvucci on the phone.

Water System Update:

Current water usage is 20 to 25 thousand GPD. That is normal for this time of the year.

Incident Reports:

We now have 13 seasonal disconnects. There were two water line breaks, one on Bear Road and one on Swiftwater Circle

.Water Meters:

There are 3 currently installed and plans set for two more.

Bear Road Project:

Don continues to work with Horne and others on getting this project scheduled. Looks very unlikely it will get done this year.

Lower Dam and Spillway Project:

Don, Bob, and Ken met with Jeff Tucker from D&K Engineering. They have lost 8 people but have hired 20 new people and are adding two more office locations. Everyone agreed that they are the right company to use to complete this project.

Nobis Engineering – Water Sourcing:

Karl Karlson from Nobis was here to take some water samples at the MtBE site. They are still working with the state to get funding for a new larger well at that site.

2018 Budget

Budget items have been submitted for review.

Upper Dam Outlet Barrel:

Bob submitted a proposal from HEB Engineers to provide the background research to determine the eligibility for FEMA and NHDOT funding for this project. The cost is \$1,500. We all agreed to accept the proposal.
