

Mountain Lakes District Water Committee Report for December 2018

This report covers the activities during December and the monthly meeting of January 10th.

Mountain Lakes District Water Committee Meeting of 1/10/2019.

Meeting was held from 8:17 AM to 10:29 AM. Attendees: Bob Long, Don Drew, Ken King, and Mark Johanson. Jim Vernon from Nobis joined us at 9:00.

Water System Update: Current water usage is about 23,000 GPD. This is normal for this time of the year.

Incident Reports:

Leak noise by Rogers Rd and White Mountain Rd.

Bear Road Project:

This is on hold until the water flow on Kearsarge is determined.

Lower Dam and Spillway Project:

The state is expected to approve the current plan which calls for a berm to be added. Once we have the OK from the state we will plan for a spring project.

SCADA system:

The system is installed and up and running. We have decided to use the Omni Meter from EJ Prescott for the pump house meters.

New Meters for the Chambers:

Don is still working on this.

Nobis Engineering – Water Sourcing:

We had a long discussion with Jim Vernon. The pumping was completed at the MtBE site. The final amount of MtBE was very small and it would not stop us from developing the site. So the state feels that the remediation is complete. We will have to pay for any future work done. Jim wants to do another pumping with a bigger pump to see if we can increase the yield. He also wants to do some pumping on a smaller monitoring well in that area to check the yield on it. We will then make a decision on what to develop into a production well. This will take a significant amount of time (1 to 2 years) and a significant amount of money (minimum of 100,000 \$).

New Business:

Hood's Plumbing & Heating was awarded the emergency water repairs bid and the head of Hood's was hired to be the person that monitors the system on a daily basis and makes any repairs needed.
