

Mountain Lakes District Water Committee Report for January 2018

This report covers the activities during January and the monthly meeting of February 1st. There was no report for December 2017. We had a leak of 30,000 gallons per day. We talked about that and everyone went on with whatever they could do to help.

Mountain Lakes District Water Committee Meeting of 2/1/2018.

Meeting was held from 8:00 AM to 8:30 AM. Attendees: Bob Long, Don Drew, Ken King, and Peter Olander.

Water System Update:

Current water usage is about 23 thousand GPD. That is normal for this time of the year.

Incident Reports:

We now have 15 seasonal disconnects. There were 10 water line breaks during the past two months.

.Water Meters:

There are 7 currently installed. We have one installed in the distribution lines and we expect to install another four such meters.

Bear Road Project:

This project will get done this spring!

Lower Dam and Spillway Project:

Dubois & King have been working with the state on what is needed to complete this project.

Nobis Engineering – Water Sourcing:

Nobis expects to do this project in the spring.

2018 Budget

Budget items have been submitted for review. The annual water cost will be increased and we are looking at adding another person on at least a part-time basis to focus on maintenance of the water system.

Upper Dam Outlet Barrel:

No update.

SCADA system:

There was a meeting with Laviollete Controls. They design and install SCADA (Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition) systems for water systems. This would allow us to monitor and control our water system from one location. It could also be expanded to include monitoring the water meters within the distribution system to help detect and monitor water leaks.
