### **Mountain Lakes District Water Committee Meeting of 3/7/2019.**

Meeting was held from 8:02 AM to 9:00 AM. Attendees: Bob Long, Don Drew, Ken King, and Ed Rajsteter .

**Water System Update:** Current water usage is about 17 to 18,000 GPD. The two major breaks have been fixed.

### **Incident Reports:**

We used Greg Pybuyn and sons to locate the leaks and then Hood to repair them. This is working out well.

### **Bear Road Project:**

While doing some of the above fixes, Don found that it was possible to work in the Bear Road area and still have good water pressure in other areas. So we will be able to move ahead on replacing a section of Bear Road water pipe.

### **Lower Dam and Spillway Project:**

We have another meeting set for March 21<sup>st</sup> with D&K to discuss this project and how we may be able to do some of the work ourselves.

### **SCADA system:**

The system is installed and up and running.

### **New Meters for the Chambers:**

Don is still working on this.

### **New Business:**

There was a new issue that came up. Hood had completed a repair and turned the water back on. This was too much for the internal valve which and flooded the basement. The question is that of liability. Is that Hood or us? Bob and Don will talk to our legal people and our insurance people about this. The answer from legal is that it is up to the homeowner to hire an approved vendor to fix the faucet and install a pressure reducer if there is not already one there.
