

Mountain Lakes District Water Committee Report for January 2019

This report covers the activities during January and the monthly meeting of February 14th,

Mountain Lakes District Water Committee Meeting of 2/14/2019.

Meeting was held from 8:04 AM to 9:25 AM. Attendees: Bob Long, Don Drew, Ken King, Ed Rajsteter and Robert Roudebush. Jeff Tucker from D&K joined us to discuss the Lower Dam spillway project and Scott Clang was also there.

Water System Update: Current water usage is about 40,000 GPD. This indicates there is a leak in the system.

Incident Reports:

After the meeting, Scott and Don focused on finding the leak. They found a leak on White Mountain Drive. However, before they could fix that, there was another leak on Gateway Drive. That has been fixed and they will continue the other one.

Bear Road Project:

This is on hold until the water flow on Kearsarge is determined. We must focus more attention on this project and complete it this year.

Lower Dam and Spillway Project:

Jeff Tucker gave us a very complete update on this project. We have permission from the state to use a berm for this project. That will make it quicker and less expensive. We had decided to use D&K for this project as they already had all of the data on the lower dam needed to complete the project. Jeff will complete the plan, get our approval, and submit it to the state for their approval.

We also talked about the system that maintains the level of the upper lake. The state inspected it last year and said it was in better shape than expected. After the inspection this year, we will try and get an estimate as to when it will need to be replaced.

SCADA system:

The system is installed and up and running.

New Meters for the Chambers:

Don is still working on this.

New Business:

There was a new issue that came up. Hood had completed a repair and turned the water back on. This was too much for the internal valve which and flooded the basement. The question is that of liability. Is that Hood or us? Bob and Don will talk to our legal people and our insurance people about this.
