

## **Mountain Lakes District Water Committee Report for December 2015**

This report covers the monthly meeting of 12/3/15 and other water related issues for the month..

### **Mountain Lakes District Water Committee Meeting of 12/3/2015**

Status: Draft as of 1/6/16 – Reviewed as of 1/7/16 – Approved as of 1/7/16

This was the December Water Committee Meeting. It was held from 8:00 AM to 9:00 AM on 12/03/15. Attendees: Don Drew, Bob Long, Ed Rajsteter and Ken King.

We approved the Water Committee Report for November 2015.

### **Water System Status**

The system is running well. We are using about 20,000 gallons per day. This was up to 30,000 during the Thanksgiving holiday period.

There was a water main break on Bear Road and a service line repair for Jim Fallon's house. A new service line was added for Bob Long's new house.

### **Nobis Engineering Projects**

Nobis was on site at the lodge area. They did not find any contamination but there is a rock ledge after about 7 feet. So this will not work as a location for the current water source work being done by Nobis.

### **Lower Lake Spillway – Connole Status**

An increased final offer was made and accepted.

### **Lower Dam Project Activities in October**

The Enhanced Monitoring Plan required by the state was completed by D&K and submitted to the state. We have made it clear to D&K that we expect D&K and CCS to cover any increased costs associated with the Enhanced monitoring effort.

Don has been working on our Emergency Action Plan. It also needs to be approved by the state and tested.

Once the state approves everything, they should then issue the refill permit for the lower lake.
