Water Status:

There were 3 incident reports – an alarm due to a power failure, a curb stop that had to be replaced, and a water turn off.

Usage remains high.

The valve on Roger's Road was repaired on the 17th.

Don has signed up for a course in leak detection this September. On the 16th, Warren Verga was here to talk about and demonstrate some of the latest equipment for leak detection.

Master Plan Update:

The survey was completed. A summary of the results was presented at the August Commissioner's meeting..

Conolle property/spillway:

The Haverhill Planning Board has decided that the lot being offered as part of this agreement is non-conforming due to size. There is work that needs to be done on the spillway. We have a deeded right to maintain the spillway.

Lower Dam Project:

We are still waiting for CCS to determine if they will do the landscaping work. If they refuse, the work will be done and charged to them.
