Mountain Lakes District Water Committee Meeting of 1/7/16

Status: Draft as of 2/2/16 – Reviewed as of 2/4/16 – Approved as of 2/4/16

This was the January Water Committee Meeting. It was held from 8:15 AM to 9:11 AM on 1/7/16.

Attendees: Don Drew, Bob Long, Ed Rajsteter and Ken King.

We approved the Water Committee Report for December 2015.

We also approved the renewal of the Water System contracts with Horne Excavation and Harold Clough.

The budget for the Water Department for 2016 was completed.

Water System Status

The system is running well. We are using about 25,000 gallons per day. There have been no incident reports. All of the samples have been taken on the lead and copper issue and submitted to the state.

Master Plan

The district will be using a person from an outside group to help organize the effort in this area. Estimated cost is about \$10,000.

Nobis Engineering Projects

Nobis was here on January 29th. They drilled 3 more wells at the lodge and 3 more at another site that some old plans show may have been where the oil tanks were.. We should have some results back by our next meeting.

Lower Dam Project Activities in January

The Emergency Action Plan was completed and tested. Don and Shawn completed the first session of our Enhanced Monitoring Plan. Don said the system was looking good with minimal leakage.

The state has issued the Refill Permit. It will still take some time for the refill process as it has to be done slowly.
