Mountain Lakes District Water Committee Meeting of 8/2/2018.

Meeting was held from 8:00 AM to 8:50 AM. Attendees: Bob Long, Don Drew, Ken King, Peter Olander, Ed Rajsteter, Joe Mitchell, Tony Salucci and Robert Roudebush.

Water System Update: Current water usage is about 44,000 GPD. That is normal for this time of the year

Incident Reports:

.Water Meters:

No work in this area until Fall.

Bear Road Project:

This is on hold until the water flow on Kearsarge is determined. We may be able to get some support from the state in this area.

Lower Dam and Spillway Project:

D&K will write up a proposal including a hydraulic analysis for our approval and submission to NH DES Dam Safety

Nobis Engineering – Water Sourcing: We have completed an application for a grant to cover some of the cost involved in making this a production well. We are #64 on the state's list so it may take a while.

Upper Dam Outlet Barrel:

We need to understand when the state will make us replace this and what design options are available.

SCADA system:

The system is installed and up and running. We need to add some additional items for the pump house meters.

New Meters for the Chambers:

Don has one quote and is waiting to get another.

Valve Repair at Hanover and King:

This was done with Paige Excavation but it is a very unusual valve and the whole approach has to be rethought.

New Business:

Standby power for pump house – Meeting with Paul Hatch on 8/13 to go over available grants.
