**Old Business:**

- **Trunk Or Treat:** There were ten vehicles at the Trunk Or Treat and between 50-60 tricksters. Bob Long sent a warm thank you to Officer Mitchell for his participation in the event.

**New Business:**

- Plans for Holiday Tree Lighting on Saturday, December 3, 5pm at the District Office.
- Plans with Haverhill Recreation to have Winterfest at the Lodge on Sunday, February 19 from 12-4pm.
