

RECREATION COMMITTEE MEETING
October 7, 2020 via ZOOM Video Conferencing

Bob Long called the meeting to order at 5:01 pm. He read a statement that the Board was authorized to meet electronically due to the declared state of emergency (COVID-19), that the meeting had been properly noticed and information given to the public on how to join the meeting via Zoom Video Conferencing, and that all votes would be by roll call, in accordance with the provisions of the Governor's emergency order.

Bob Long gave an update on District work projects: The pool work has been completed. Work on French Pond Road has been paved, with a re-do on in wash out areas. Waterlines were replaced on Bear Road and the spillway repair completed to help conservation of the Upper Lake.

Don Drew sent information for purchasing 2 new grills. Since prices exceeded Recreation funds, Barbara Keating said she would find alternative prices before we go to the budget committee to ask for more funds.

Dottie Long reported on prices for sweatshirts, hats, and beach towels from Green Mountain Monogram and has placed an order with them for holiday sales.

The committee unanimously voted to have the Tailgate Trick or Treat on Saturday, October 24th. Set-up at 4:30, Trick & Treating from 5-6pm at the beach parking area with social distancing, masks and gloves required. Wrapped candy in plastic bags. Please see DMAIL for details.

Concern for clean-up and maintenance of lake beaches during the fall and winter months was discussed, particularly Lower Lake trash. The committee recommends this as an action item to the commissioners.
